# OUR DONATIONS

As part of our ongoing pledge to reduce our wastage and become more sustainable in our business practice, any designs that you do not wish to keep are taken back to our warehouse in Windsor post-event, and donated to our network of local charities and organisations. This prevents flowers being wasted and instead gives them a second purpose which supports the local community, spreading joy, wellness and education.

Already in 2023 with donations alone, we have collectively raised over £14,389 for a range of charities and organisations that help support the local community. All suitable flowers are gifted to local Hospices to either be used to decorate bedrooms and communal spaces or for flower arranging workshops, the flowers have been used in schools for biology lessons, as activity sessions for toddlers, made into bouquets to thank teachers or sold by PTA's to raise important funds. They are often used to brighten up local community hub spaces, gifted to new families who have arrived in the area having fled domestic violence and given to our elderly neighbours who live in sheltered housing. It is not only fantastic to be able to support so many people, but as a direct result of this service, our waste has reduced by 70%, meaning that our carbon footprint has also reduced dramatically, helping our pledge to become carbon neutral by the end of 2024. This service is totally free of charge and we aim to let you know where your flowers went within a few days.

If you are concerned about event waste, this provides a method to ensure that you can still hold the perfect experience for clients, employees or stakeholders, whilst still being mindful about the social and environmental impact. Any waste that cannot be donated is collected into our green waste bins and composted to make natural fertiliser.










Statement floral designs for the opening of the 2023 Serpentine Pavilion. We designed a beautiful canopy arrangement over the central bar, overflowing with seasonal florals, alongside further statement designs for the entrance, the bars and to dress the space. The florals were bright and colourful to represent the natural beauty of summer, with inclusion of florals with links to France and Lebanon to reflect the Lina Ghotmeh's architectural design influences.











For a stylish and bold aesthetic reminiscent of McDonald's, we curated a captivating design featuring a dominant presence of red blooms such as Dahlias, Astilbe, Peonies, Sweet Peas, and Garden Spray Roses. These vibrant florals were artfully juxtaposed against contemporary yellow accents, creating a dynamic interplay of colours. To further enhance the visual impact, we introduced touches of yellow Craspedia arranged in striking contrast to red bud vases, elevating the overall composition.
