QUEEN'S HOUSE, GREENWICH

Event: Special Birthday throughout London, ending with dinner in Queens House

Brief: We were asked to create a feeling of intimacy and warmth in a ballroom for just 4 guests, creating pockets of wow-factor moments throughout the event journey.

Season: Summer - We lent heavily on the citrus tones that come through in early July to help lift the space. These tones worked especially well in the planted 'garden' installation. Using the contrasting colours to highlight the negative space, mix of textures and varieties which enhanced the growing effect. To ground this, birch trees were used at each end to help draw the eye up and included the chandeliers which hung above the table.





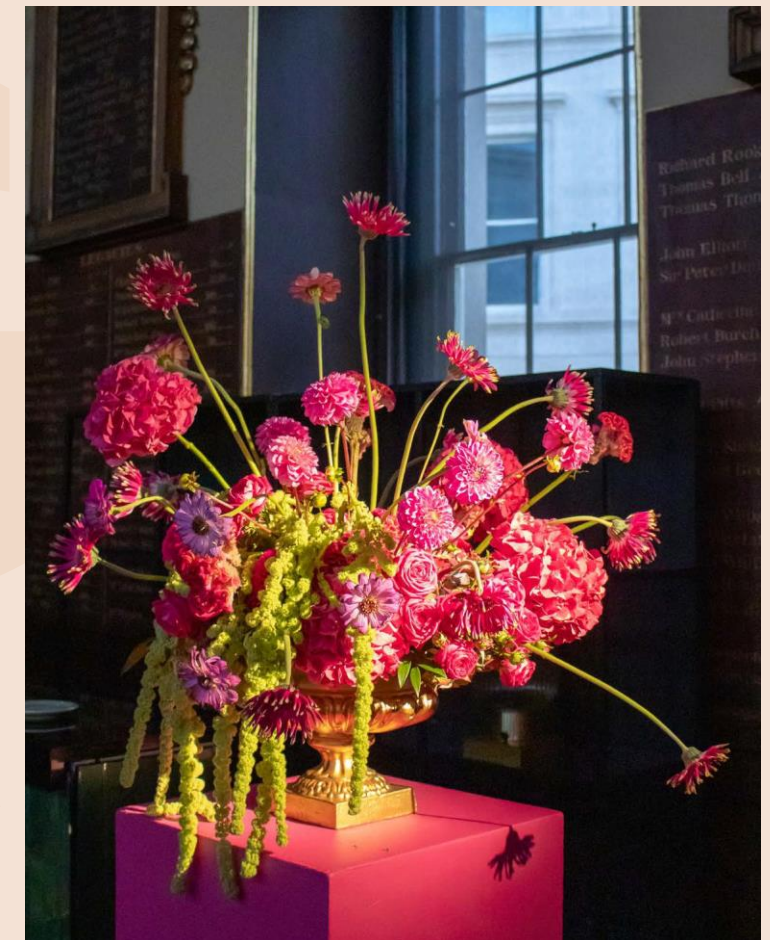
ST PAUL'S CATHEDRAL

Event: Luxury Brand Event

Brief: Seasonal designs with elements of elegance and luxury.

Season: Early Summer – Inspired by St Pauls itself, the tablescape used dark green foliage and gold accents to contrast against the white blousy flowers. Creating height using large lamps allowed us to add dimension to the table, bringing the eye upwards, highlighting the venues unique features.





BART'S HERITAGE

Event: Venue launch party

Brief: To present the historical space in a fresh and unexpected way using contemporary styling. Featuring bold pink and lime green tones to create a vibrant, modern aesthetic as a juxtaposition to the buildings history.

Season: Late summer - highlighting stems including Dahlias, Gerpasta varieties, and cascading lime green Amaranthus.



PRIVATE HOME

Event: A Bridgerton Extravaganza for a 21st birthday party

Brief: 160 guests in a bespoke marquee full of grandeur and opulence with a modern twist on Bridgerton. Guests enjoyed a drinks reception with floral designs in pastel tones, leading through to the dining area where florals were vibrant tones to provide a 'wow' dinner and after party moment.

Season: Autumn - To illustrate the Bridgerton theme, we took inspiration from the Netflix series whilst using seasonally available florals, such as Delphinium, Roses, Guelder Rose, Hydrangea, Lisianthus and Snapdragon.



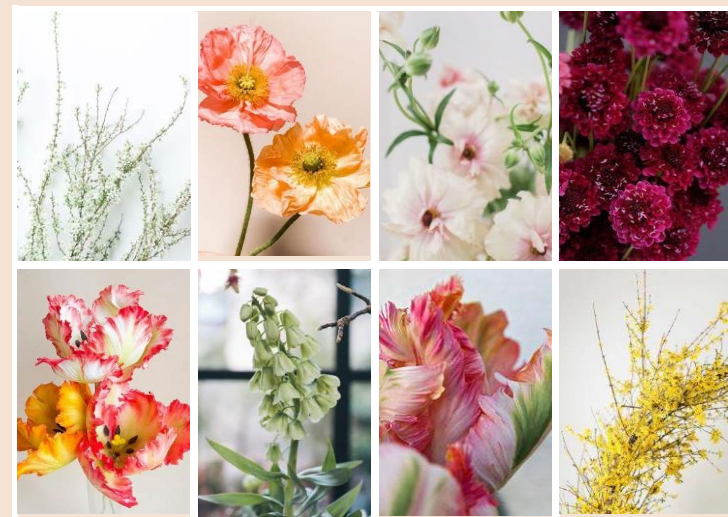
8 BISHOPSGATE

Event: London launch event for a Manchester based company

Brief: The theme was based on Manchester's iconic rave scene at Hacienda Classical with Cobalt Blue, neon Yellow and acid greens.

Season: Spring - Celebrating the colours of spring we used vibrant Iris, zesty double tulips and structural Anthurium.





NATIONAL PORTRAIT GALLERY

Event: The NPG supporters Gala

Brief: This leading cultural, high-level fundraising event will take place throughout the newly refurbished galleries, marking its highly anticipated return for the first time since 2019.

Season: Spring - Using bright and bold springtime florals to reflect the excitement for this returning event, we included Tulips, Butterfly Ranunculus, Icelandic Poppies, Fritillaria and Blossom.



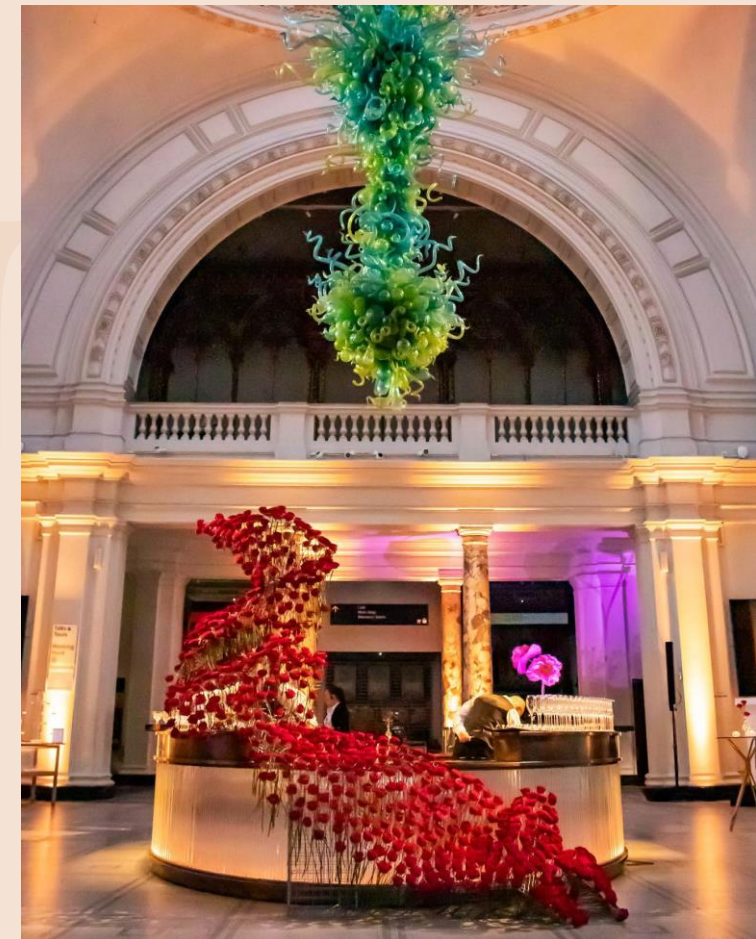


VICTORIA AND ALBERT MUSEUM

Event: A corporate client reception in the Dome, followed by a private view of the Cartier exhibition

Brief: Inspired by Cartier red, the florals created a luxurious arrival moment on the bar.

Season: Late Spring - florals in deep red tones that embodied the clients branding, included seasonal stems such as Ranunculus, Anemones, frilly Parrot Tulips and red Roses.





COWORTH PARK HOTEL, ASCOT

Event: Event planners' dinner

Brief: To create an unexpected dining experience within the wildflower meadow at Coworth Park.

Season: Summer - We began by framing the space to create a sense of intimacy within the open meadow. We used iron frames covered in mixed seasonal British foliage, building these up in the shape of trees. From these, festoon lights and wicker lanterns were hung which provided a warm glow as dusk fell. On the table, we used mixed terracotta vases with rattan accents. The flowers included subtle tones of cream Stocks and peach Dahlias with bright Marigolds to act as a pop of colour. Beeswax candles with fresh lemons and peaches completed the look, creating the perfect summer outdoor experience.





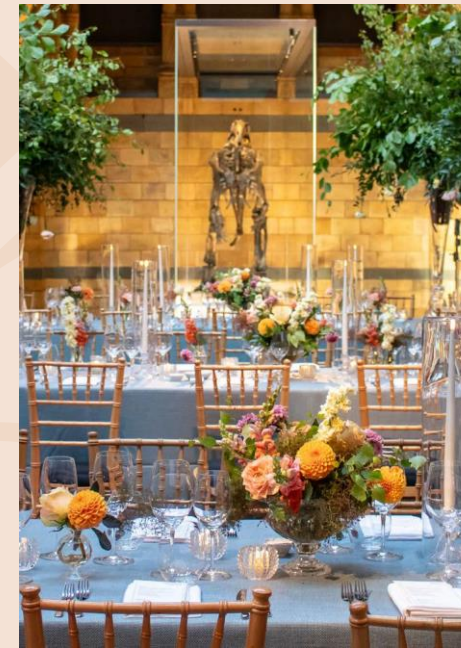
PRIVATE HOME

Event: Intimate Birthday dinner

Brief: To transform the family home into a 'holiday from home'. The birthday girl's favourite location to join her family on holiday is 'Ibiza', with all designs providing an intimate and mediterranean ambiance.

Season: Autumn - To illustrate the Mediterranean theme, we used seasonally available florals to provide the aesthetic including Solidago, Cosmos, Phlox, Roses, Oxypetalum, Ammi Majus and Olive with Rosemary and Thyme for added scent. These complimented the use of rattan vases, placemats and tones of green in the glassware and crockery.





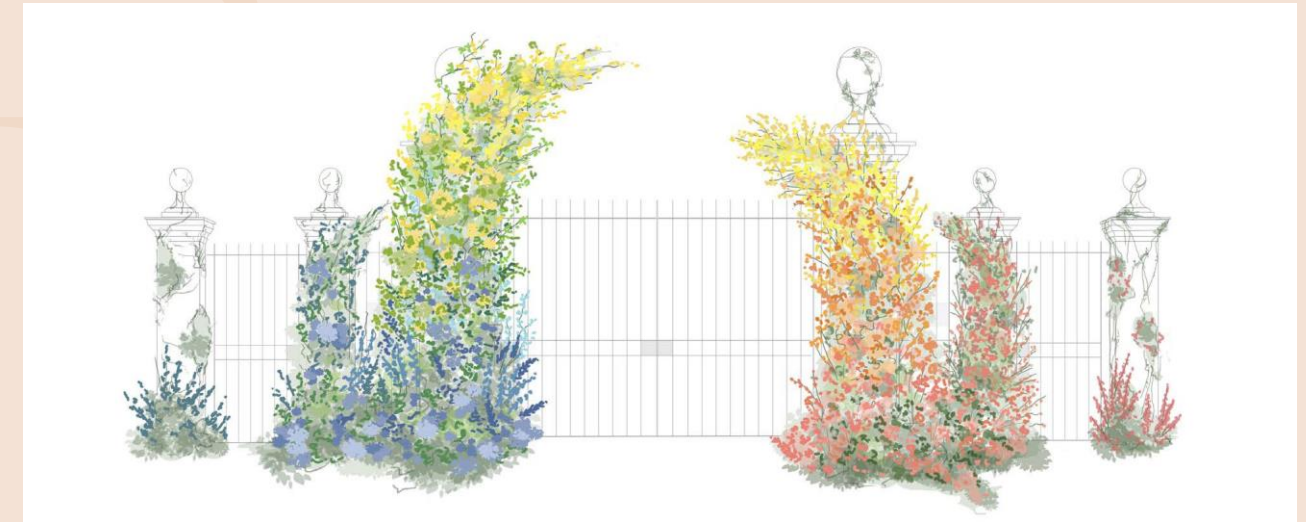
NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM

Event: Corporate Investor 40th Anniversary Dinner

Brief: To create a magnificent secret garden feel within the Hintze Hall using tall foliage tree designs with dangling roses, and organic seasonal florals throughout, incorporating orange and peach to represent the branding colours.

Season: Summer - To illustrate the natural garden theme, we used seasonally available foliage and florals, including Beech, Betula, Smokebush, Cotinus and soft Ruscus, alongside Dahlia, Antirrhinum, Roses, Stocks, and Scabious. The use of glass vessels allowed the varied textures of the foliage and florals to truly stand out.





RHS CHELSEA FLOWER SHOW LONDON GATES

Event: Chelsea Gates

Brief: Showstopping celebration of the RHS Chelsea Flower Show.

Season: Spring – We are so proud to have created this design for the RHS using a mix of British and Dutch flowers. This display allowed us to showcase striking colour contrasts across each of the gate pillars. Incorporating a rich blend of textures and tones that created a welcoming, immersive atmosphere for guests as they entered the showgrounds. Crafted entirely using sustainable techniques, the installation was designed for effortless daily refreshes, allowing us to update the florals each morning and ensure the display looked its best throughout the event.

White Farm Peonies - On the Suffolk/Essex border, White's high quality peonies are well known for their Peonies strong stems and large, full heads.
